## RULES AND REGULATIONS OF TALENT DEMO 2017

1. Talent Demo is part of the official program of Camerimage Film Festival.
2. Talent Demo is produced by Tumult Foundation (Camerimage Film Festival organizer).
3. Talent Demo is an advisory program addressed primarily to students and young independent filmmakers. Its aim is to advise on the development and promotion of film projects.
4. Advice will be given by film industry experts invited to Camerimage Film Festival.
5. A typical group of experts might include representatives of the following professions:
  - recognised cinematographer
  - talent agent
  - producer
  - director
  - distributor
  - representative of an international film festival
6. Talent Demo participants will be selected based on their **Application Forms** (available for download here: [www.camerimage.pl](http://www.camerimage.pl) >> Camerimage 2017 >> Talent Demo) including **project description in English**.
7. Applications will be accepted for consideration upon payment of **PLN 50.00 registration fee by 30 October 2017. This payment can only be made by credit card in the Dotpay system.**

Online payment form will be made available through a dedicated link forwarded by Talent Demo coordinator to the submitter's email.

8. The organizers will select Talent Demo participants based on submitted application materials. Each participant will have two film industry experts assigned to them, based on the requirements presented in the application.
9. The experts will receive participants' projects for review in advance.
10. During Camerimage Film Festival, each participant will meet their assigned experts in order to discuss the project.
11. Each session with the expert will take **30 minutes** and shall be conducted **in English**.
12. One participant can only introduce one project during the session.
13. The organizer reserves the right to cancel a session with the expert and appoint another one with similar experience and profession. The organizer will keep Talent Demo participants informed about any changes.
14. No fees will be refunded if a participant decides to withdraw their application.
15. The participants need to collect their Talent Demo tickets at the Festival Reception, upon presentation of a valid ID. These tickets allow participation in the Talent Demo advisory program alone. For other Camerimage events a separate Entry Card, purchased in compliance with the rules and regulations available at [www.camerimage.pl](http://www.camerimage.pl), shall be required.
16. Deadline for Talent Demo application submissions: **30 October 2017**.
